

17: Pence Per Litre (PPL) Discount

This PPL discount function is designed to be a quick way to setup a discount on fuel that is selected manually from the POS screen. Useful for promotions such as a 2PPL off at a weekend or offering customers in the local postcode a discount on fuel. PPL discounts are configured in Prism.

From the front POS Screen -> when the fuel sale is displayed in the transaction window -> PPL Discount

1 Select the appropriate PPL discount.

If **Other** is selected the PPL discount will need to be manually keyed in. Entry over the maximum value (10p) will not be accepted.

2 Take payment in the usual way.

3 The applied discount will be visible in the transaction window, on the customer receipt and in the transaction journal.

There is no maximum litreage on a PPL discount.

The discount is only applied to whole litres.

Configure POS Discount Reasons as desired using the grid below.

The minimum and maximum discount values can be set to the same value, resulting in a pre-defined discount being given. Alternatively the cashier will be required to enter a discount value.
